- Team leader in scoring (14.1) and rebounding (5.7).
- Leads **all freshmen in the Mid-American Conference** in scoring and is ninth overall.
- Hitting 55 percent of her shots from the field, which is leading the team and is fifth in the MAC.
- Named MAC East Division Player of the Week following her 23-point, eight-rebound performance against Saint Francis (Dec. 17)—added a career-high five steals in the game.
- Exploded for a career-high 30 points, three points shy of Miami's single-game record, in just her second collegiate game and seven rebounds against Boston (Nov. 19)—11-for-16 from the field and 8-of-11 at the charity stripe—named to Boston University Invitational all-tournament team.
- Recorded a career-high 12 rebounds and added 19 points (8-of-19 shooting) in Miami's win over Wright State (Dec. 2).
- Connected on 8-of-12 shots and 17 points versus Austin Peay (Nov. 25), while snagging four boards.
- Nailed 8-of-10 shots from the field en route to a game-high 19 points versus Ohio (Feb. 14)
- Had 17 points and 11 rebounds, both team highs, against Detroit (Dec. 6).

- Tallied 13 points and 11 caroms vs. Valparaiso (Dec. 31).
- Nailed 19 points, four rebounds and four steals vs. Toledo (Jan. 6).
- Hit for 18 points and snagged six rebounds in Miami's victory over Central Michigan (Jan. 13).
- Tallied 13 points, five assists and a career-high five steals in Miami's 88-57 upset against Kent State (Jan. 30).
- Notched a team-high 22 points (10-of-17 shooting) and added seven boards and three assists versus Ball State (Feb. 3).
- Recorded a team-best 19 points and grabbed four boards in just 21 minutes versus Bowling Green (Feb. 12).
- Has three double-doubles on the year—Wright State, Detroit and Valparaiso.
- Has led or tied for the team lead in scoring in 13 of Miami's 23 games this year, including the last three contests.
